about the Fen?

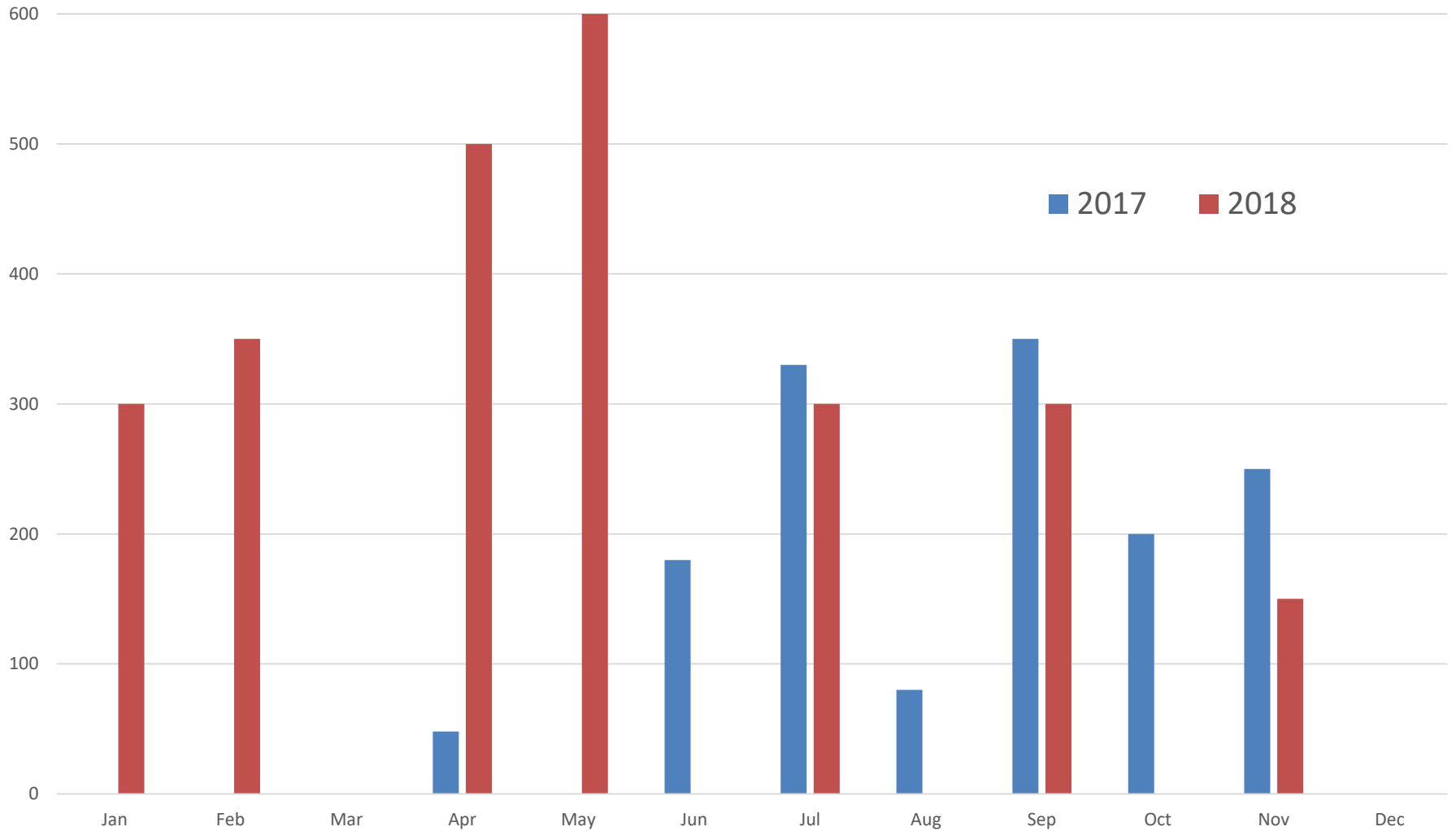
It is possible to restore a wetland meadow by removing topsoil, raising the water level, and sowing with an appropriate seed mix

healthy



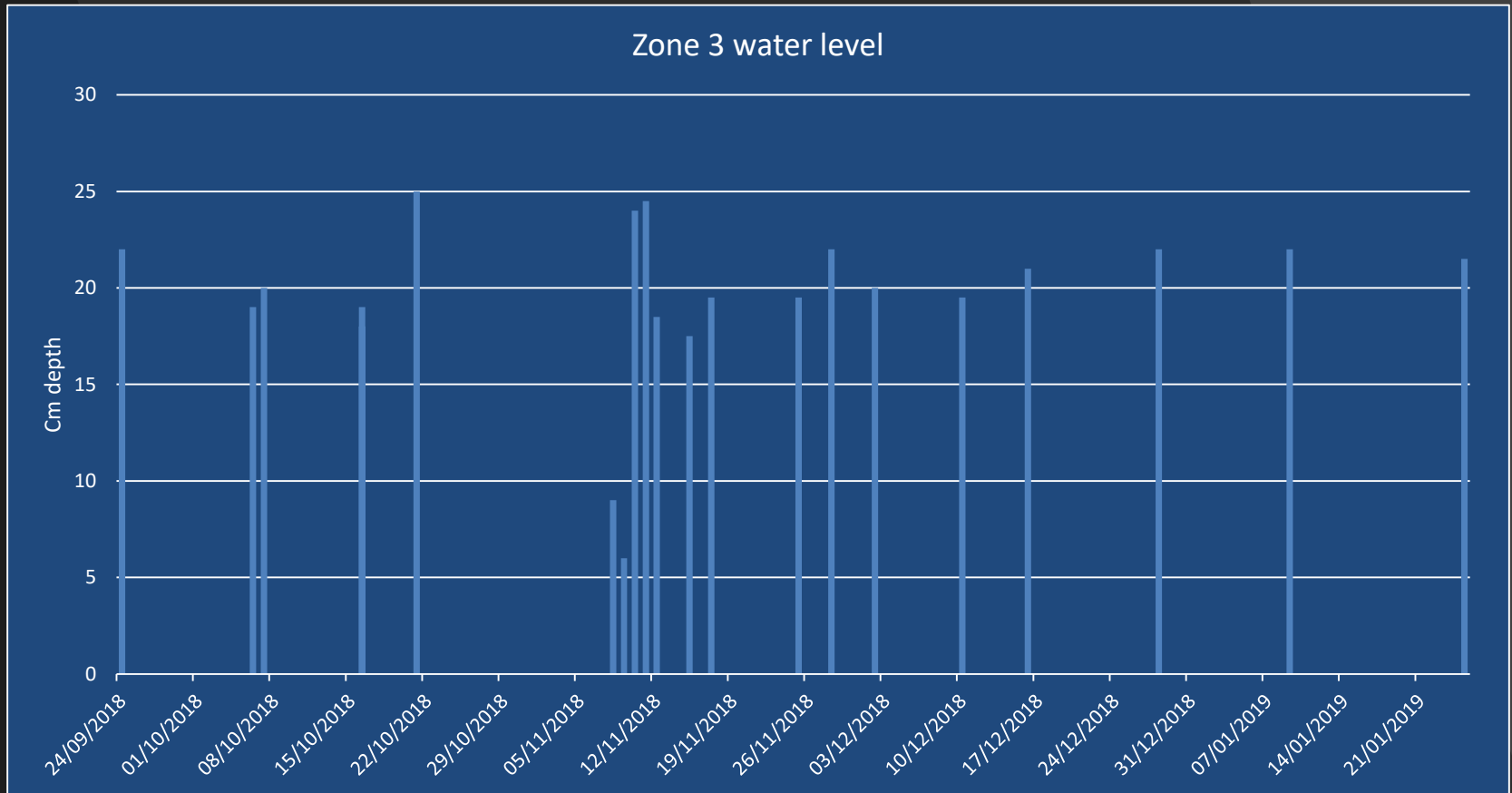
Freshwater Shrimp (Gammarus) counts





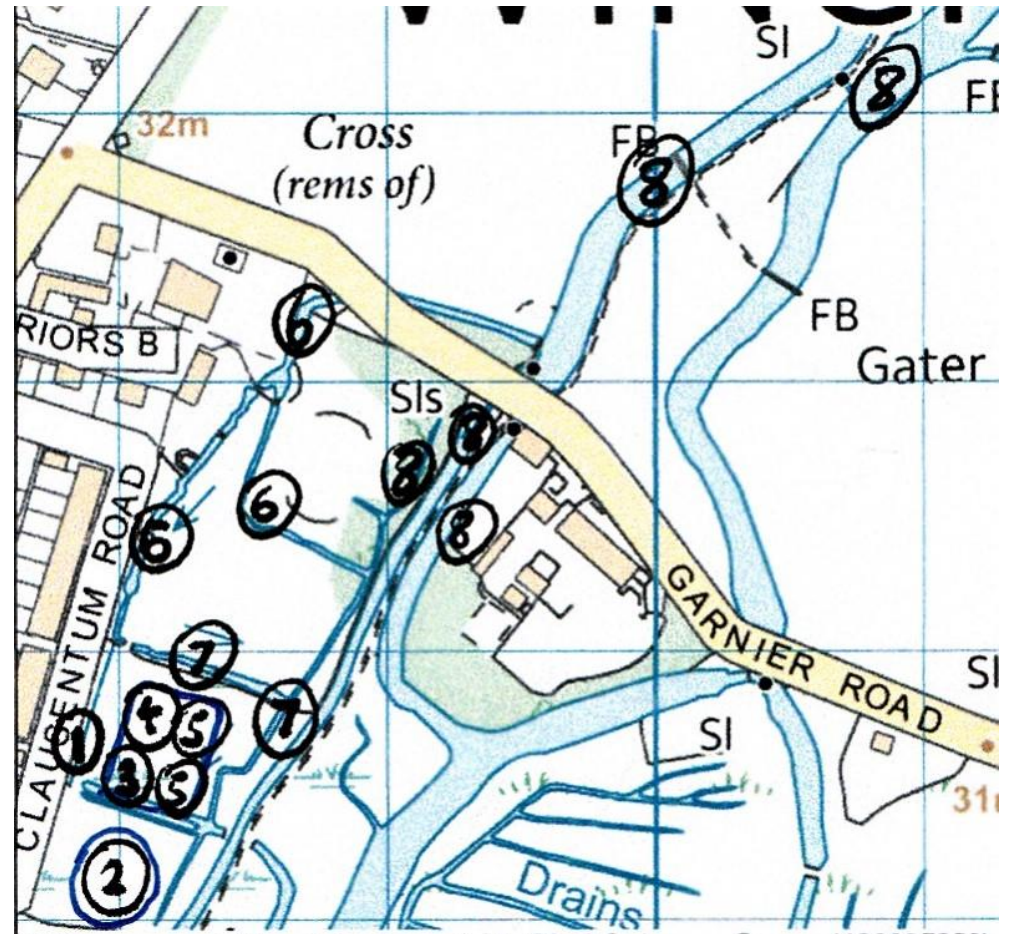


Zone 3 water level

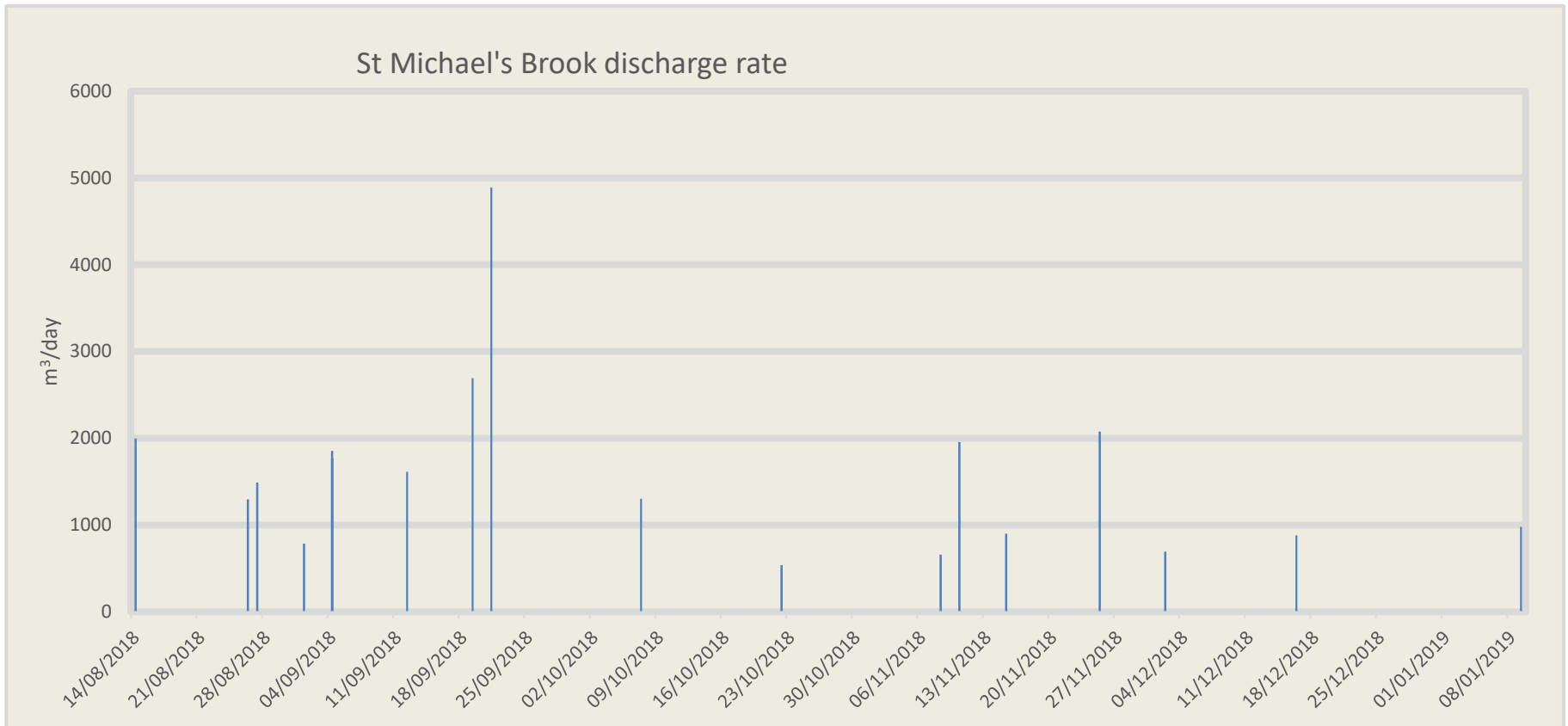


Water temperature

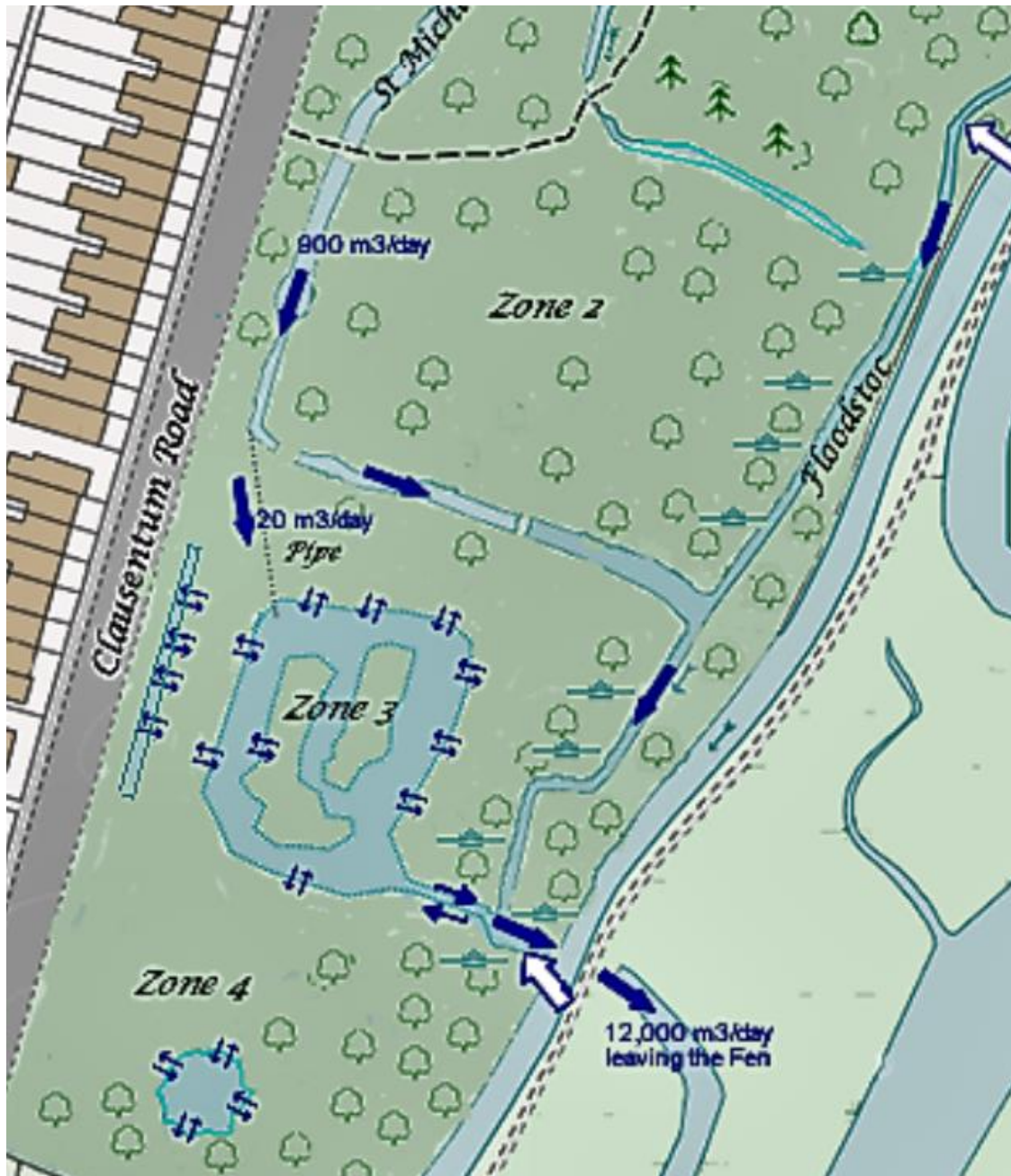

Water flow in St Michael's Brook

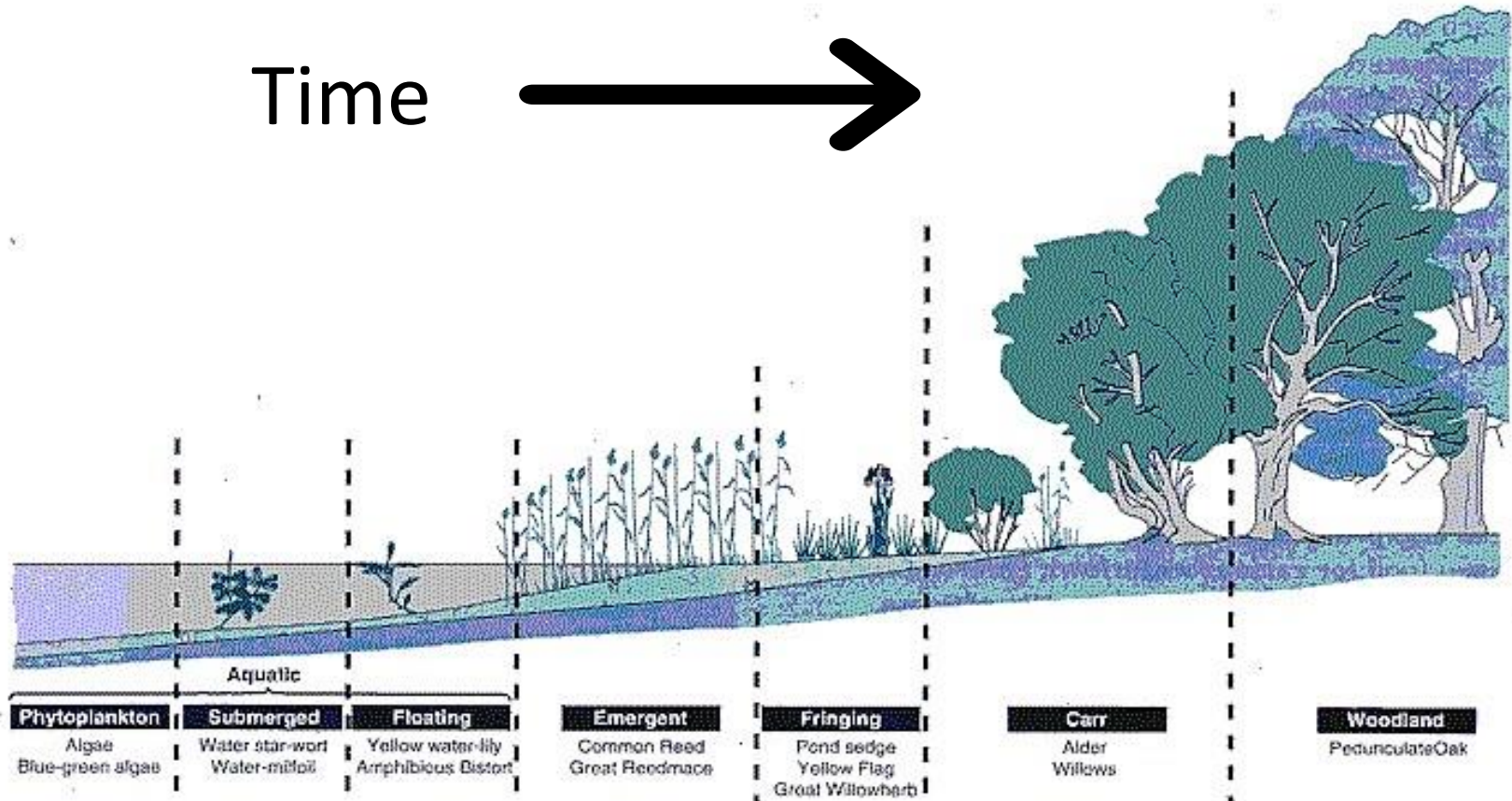


Water flow
