Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer presented a reconciliation of the 2024 accounts. Thanks to a generous donation our financial position is stable. From time to time we do need to purchase new items of equipment and we pay an annual insurance premium to Zurich. It was felt that a new pitchfork would be our next expenditure. Santander will be charging us for our banking from September so we will have to look elsewhere.

Health and Safety Policy/Risk Assessment

These were reviewed and some minor changes were made to the Risk Assessment.

Chairman's comments and discussion

Firstly, we noted formally the sad death during the year of Ivor Snook, who was a great supporter of our work, both financially and in spirit. Although his health failed in recent years he was still very much interested in what was happening on the Fen.

Our conservation work continues in its familiar pattern, with assistance from the boys of Winchester College. We appear to have successfully eradicated Himalayan Balsam from the Fen at present, as there has been no sign of any new plants this season. A large multi-stemmed crack willow that was leaning over into the St Faith's School conservation area was removed by HCC contractors, letting in a lot of light to the area near the pond.
