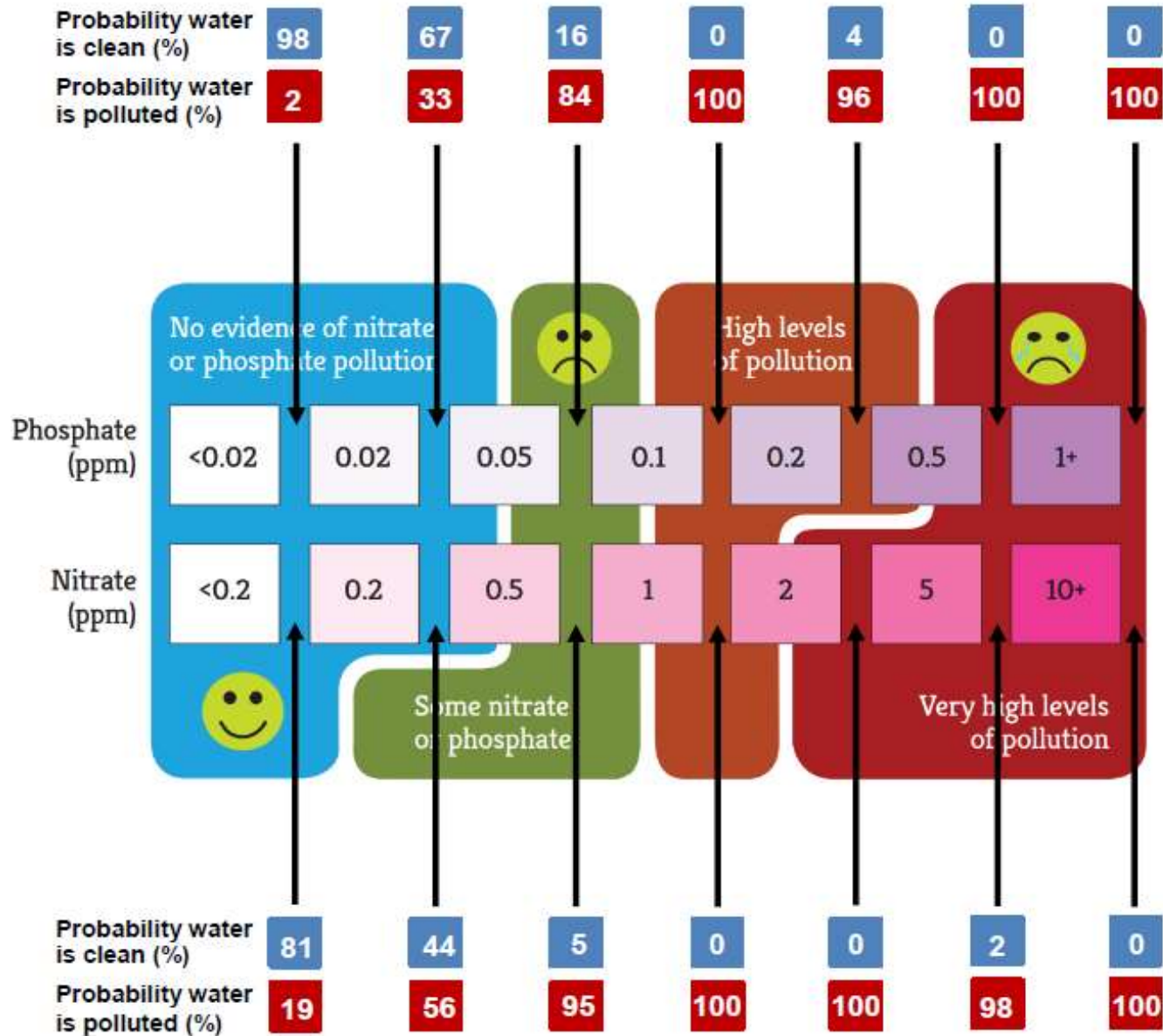

19,000 m³/day

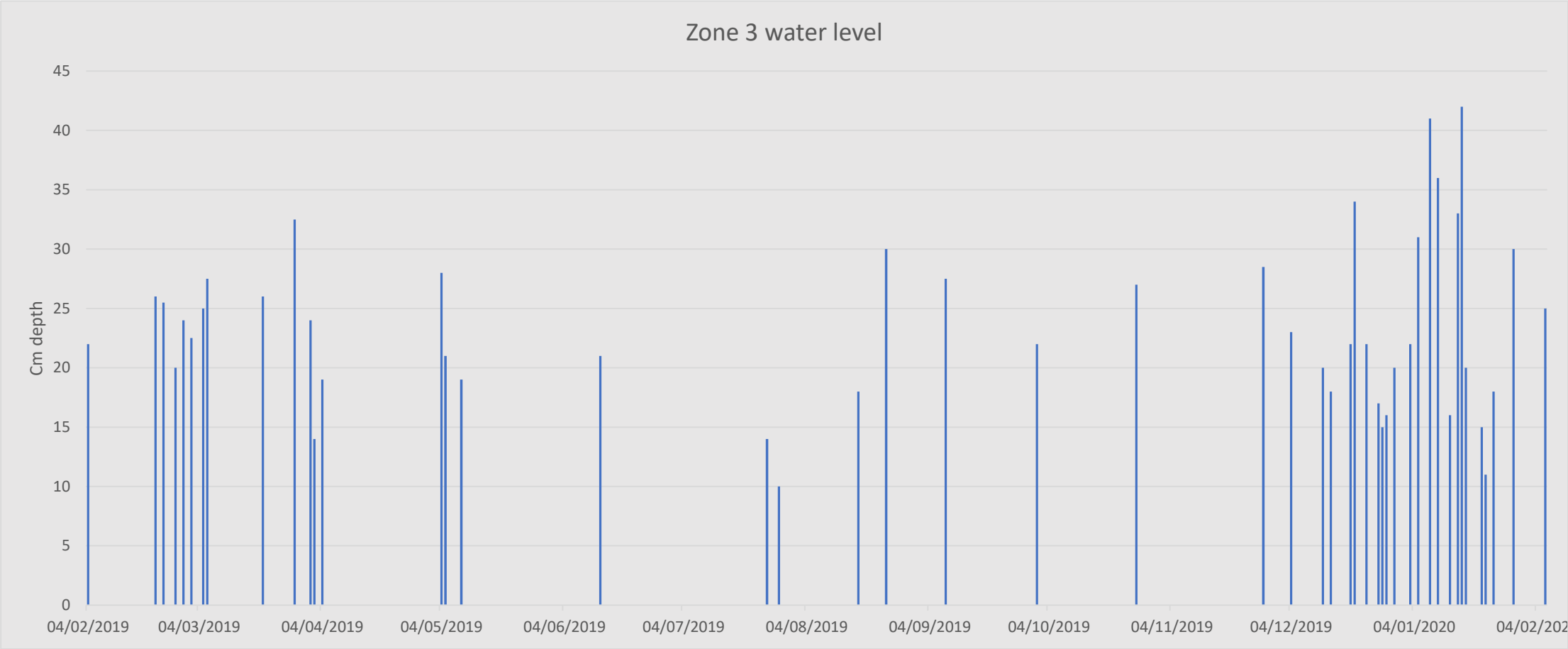

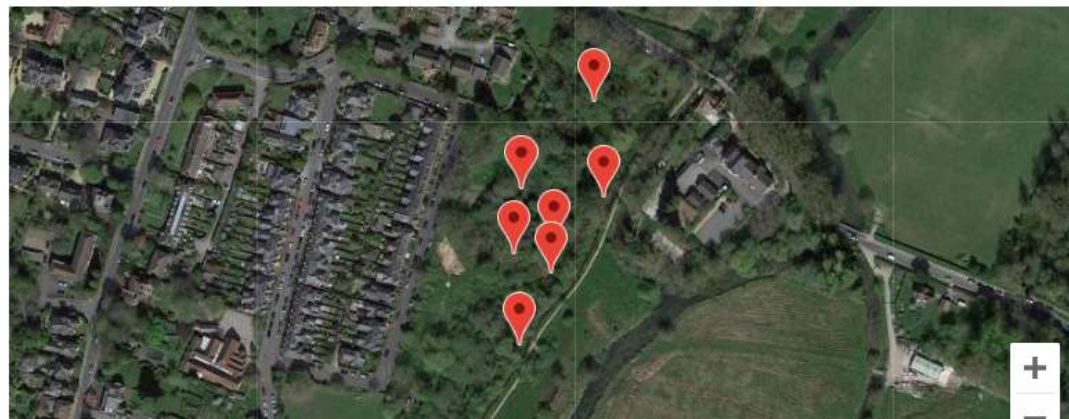
